### **2006 Southern Downs Sculpture Symposium Warwick Shire 17 to 30 July 2006 Leslie Park, Warwick**

An initiative of the Killarney Area Promotions Association, this project is modeled on other successful national and international sculpture symposiums, in particular Mt. Gambier, SA and Sunshine Coast, Qld. A team of five sculptors will be recruited to the area for two weeks to sculpture Warwick sandstone into individual pieces telling "Stories of the Shire".

Sculptors will work in the highly visible venue of Leslie Park, Warwick so progress can be viewed and enjoyed by the general public.

The finished sculptures, monumental in size, will be donated to and located in five of the smaller Warwick Shire communities being Allora, Emu Vale, Dalveen, Killarney and Leyburn.

### Why Warwick Shire ?

Warwick has more than a 100 year history of expressionism in sandstone, both as a natural resource and within the built environment, being part of the Southern Downs Heritage and Historic building trail. Warwick boasts grand public buildings of sandstone and its own sandstone quarries. Historically, Warwick shire was the site for the first, free white settlement in Queensland, with indigenous occupation predating.

Resulting art works will interpret the historical foundations of the Warwick Shire in a contemporary style.

### From John Schot (97 Protection of VIPs)

.... I am sending this from Mansehra in the North West Frontier Province (NWFP) of Pakistan where I am coordinating security for UN staff members involved in the earthquake disaster relief. I expect to be here until at least early December. I am attaching a photograph I took a few days ago up at Battgram, about 50km north of here where I was doing a road assessment for humanitarian convoys. It depicts a destroyed village located on top of a hill - you will note that half the hill and village has now 'disappeared' down into the valley - just one small example of the truly terrible tragedy on 8 October.

Aftershocks and tremors are still a daily occurrence and hazard with one earlier today measuring 6 on the Richter scale.

Electricity and email connection is in short supply so must make this brief to allow others access. I hope all is well in Brisbane, best regards to all Churchill Fellows
